

This fine dust sensor can be operated utilizing the <u>Seeed PM2 5 sensor HM3301</u>, which was published by <u>Seeed Studio</u> under the <u>MIT license</u>. After installing this library in your Arduino IDE, you can find the code example **basic_demo** under *File* → *Examples* → *Grove-Laser PM2.5 Sensor HM3301*. You can upload this code sample using **Upload**. Before doing so, however, make sure that the **Port** and **Board** are set correctly under *Tools*.
